

### Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (U) Mission in Nagaon Municipal Board

The Hon'ble President of India, in his address to the Joint Session of Parliament on 9th June, 2014 had announced "By the time the Nation completes 75 years of its Independence, every family will have a pucca house with water connection, toilet facilities, 24x7 electricity supply and access."

Hon'ble Prime Minister envisioned Housing for All by 2022 when the Nation completes 75 years of its Independence. In order to achieve this objective, Central Government has launched a comprehensive mission "Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Housing for All (Urban)".

The mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through following programme verticals:

- Slum rehabilitation of Slum Dwellers with participation of private developers using land as a resource
- Promotion of Affordable Housing for weaker section through credit linked subsidy
- Affordable Housing in Partnership with Public & Private sectors
- Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction /enhancement.

In Nagaon Municipal Board, constructions of 626 nos. of houses under Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC) vertical of PMAY-HFA (Urban) are nearing completion and 3 nos. houses have already been occupied by the beneficiaries.

### Handingover Solid Waste Management equipments by NRL to Nagaon Municipal Board

### Digitisation of Nagaon Municipal Board projects

Digitisation of Nagaon Municipal Board projects is getting inaugurated on 8th March 2019 by Sri Rajen Gohain, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Railways in the august presence of Sri Rupak Sarmah, Hon'ble MLA, Nagaon Sadar Assembly constituency and the Sri Diganta Das, Chairman, Nagaon Municipal Board along with Smti. Mrinalini Roy, Vice-Chairman, Nagaon Municipal Board. The services under the project are expected to be rolled out to the citizens of Nagaon Municipal area from the 1st April 2019 in a phase-wise manner. Under this digitisation project, the entire manual records shall be digitised and cash-less mode of online payments shall be facilitated using which taxpayers shall be able to pay their taxes and license fees from the comfort of their homes. Also citizens shall be able to make applications for new holding assessment, new trade licenses & renewals, NOCs and register their complaints and grievances online.

**Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal launches water supply and beautification projects in Nagaon**



Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal on 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2019 laid the foundation of a Safe Drinking Water Project in Nagaon and also kick started the renovation works of three recreational parks as well as the installation of high mast LED lights at Nagaon town in a programme held at Nehrubali in the district. He stated that the State government has undertaken implementation of infrastructure development, water supply and beautification projects to the tune of Rs. 650 crores in four major cities of the State including Guwahati, Nagaon, Dibrugarh and Silchar under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), stated a press release.

Stating that implementation of development schemes under AMRUT would benefit 28 thousand families of Nagaon town, Chief Minister Sonowal said that being a historic town Nagaon made a significant contribution in spiritual, socio-political, literary and cultural life of the State.

Union Minister of State for Railways Rajen Gohain, Minister of State (i/c) for Urban Development Department (UDD) Pijush Hazarika, Chairperson of Assam Urban Water Supply & Sewerage Board Dr. Numal Momin and Nagaon MLA Rupak Sarma also delivered a speech on the occasion. Batadrawa MLA, Angoorlata Deka, Commissioner & Secretary, UDD SS Meenakshi Sundaram, Nagaon DC Jadav Saikia, Chairman of Nagaon Municipal Board Diganta Das and host of other dignitaries were present in the programme.

**Swachhata Hi Sewa (SHS) 2018:**

Starting from 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 a country wide sanitation initiatives was taken for over 15 days to highlight once again the Jan andolan – the Swachha Bharat Mission. Our Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has named the Sanitation campaign from 15<sup>th</sup> September to 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2018 as "Swachhata Hi Sewa". The objective of the campaign is to mobilise people and reinforce the "Jan Aandolan" for sanitation to contribute to Mahatma Gandhi's dream of a Clean India.

Nagaon Municipal Board also made elaborate plans to involve people from various walks of life and make this an unprecedented people's campaign. The activities included mass cleaning of public places, waste collection drives, door-door waste collection awareness, swachhata rallies, drawing competitions in schools, segregation of solid waste, toilet pit digging, toilet construction activities and building compost.

In this connection Nagaon Municipal Board identified special dates during the campaign period. Starting from 15<sup>th</sup> Sept. a cleanliness drive was carried out at Ward No. 11 Horizon Colony inaugurated by Hon'ble MLA Nagaon Sadar L.A.C Sri Rupak Sharma in presence of the Chairman Nagaon Municipal Board Sri Diganta Das, Vice Chairperson Sri M. Roy, Deputy Commissioner of Nagaon Sri Biswajit Pegu (IAS), Additional Deputy Commissioner and Executive Officer (ACS) Sri Jayanta Kumar Bora and Assistant Executive Engineer Sri Rajesh Kumar Das & other officials of Nagaon Municipal Board.

People were being mobilised to do large scale shramdaan for toilet construction, cleaning of public places, bus stands, schools and colleges, statues, hospitals and other commercial areas. At the culmination event on October 2<sup>nd</sup> Gandhi Jayanti, which is also the Swachha Bharat Diwas, ULB level awards for essay competitions and drawing competitions were presented to Swachhata Champions from across the city.
